Guidelines for Scholarship Awards

- The mission of Ye Notorious Krewe of the Peg Leg Pirate, Inc. is to provide assistance to amputees, families of amputees and organizations that work with amputees.
- No distinction is made with regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, marital status, personal appearance, or sexual orientation when deciding on awards of financial assistance.
- The goal of the scholarship program is to assist amputees in furthering their education. That education may be provided by an accredited college or university, community college, or vocational-trade-technical school that is state licenced.

Scholarship and Award Amount Distribution

- Scholarship award amounts are determined by the Krewe Board of Directors each year.
- Scholarships are paid directly to the accredited institution.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Have had a loss of limb.
- Eligible applicants must be accepted to an accredited university, graduate school, community college and have a GPA of at least 3.5 (based on 4.0 scale) or equivalent, if in college.

Documentation Needed (The following will be required by all applicants before the application packet will be considered):

- A total of 2 recommendations – one from a physical therapist, doctor or other medical provider and one from a teacher or counselor from high school or previous college attendance.
- An acceptance letter from a scholastic institution.
- A copy of your last IRS tax return, if you are being claimed on your parent's tax return a copy of their return is required as well.
- Transcript of academic records from high school or college, whichever is applicable.
- An essay describing your future goals (not to exceed 300 words).
- Our completed application.

Guidelines for Scholarship Renewal

Scholarship Renewal Documentation Needed:

- A copy of your last IRS tax return, if you are being claimed on your parent's tax return a copy of their return is required as well.
- Transcript of academic records from high school and/or college showing past year's grades/progress.
- An essay highlighting last years achievements (not to exceed 300 words).

The deadline for submitting a Scholarship application is March 15th
